



The points (\*) are only for the CoRSB\_JC young investigator collaborative grants. The points (~) only concern the CoRSB\_CE collaborative grants, for statutory teachers-researchers and researchers.

## Eligibility criteria:

(\*) Be a PhD student or have defended his/her PhD less than 3 years before the date of application

(~) To hold a permanent position as a researcher or teacher-researcher

Be a member of the Biomechanics Society

Request a mobility in a laboratory different from the one in which the current research activities are carried out

Duration of the mobility greater than or equal to one month

Mobility carried out in the year following the financial eligibility

Equipment and salary costs not eligible

## Constitution of the file:

A curriculum vitae (2 or 3 pages maximum)

A list of scientific production

A scientific project detailing the research objectives, the candidate's motivations, the benefits provided by the collaboration and the expected dates of mobility (4 or 5 pages maximum)

(\*) A letter of recommendation from the PhD director or the supervisor of the current year

A letter of invitation from the host laboratory

A budget estimate for travel and accommodation costs as well as possible co-financing (1 page maximum).

Proof of membership in the Biomechanics Society for the current year

## Evaluation criteria:

Applications will be examined by a selection committee; the main evaluation criteria will be based on the quality of the scientific project, the interest of the mobility as well as the academic quality of the application. Mobility in a foreign laboratory will be favored. For statutory researchers or teacher-researcher, the establishment of a new collaboration will be favored.

## Return from mobility:

At the end of their mobility, the winners will write a scientific report on the work carried out (2 to 4 pages maximum) which will be sent to the Société de Biomécanique within 2 months of their return. This report, which will be approved by the host laboratory, will also contain a "feedback" which will be put online on the website of the Société de Biomécanique.

The possible scientific productions related to the collaboration will have to acknowledge the Société de Biomécanique (funded by the Société de Biomécanique (international French speaking Society of Biomechanics). During the SB congress, the winners of the previous year will present the grants of the current year. On this occasion, they will be welcome to present their feedback.
